

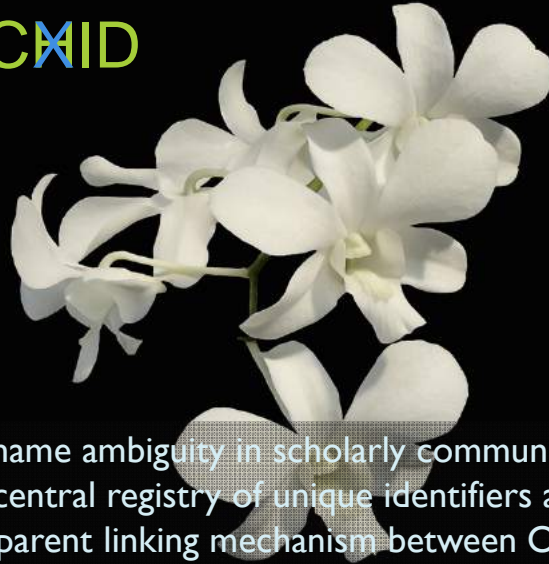

## “CJK” Challenges

- In **China**, the 100 most common last names are shared by over three-quarters of the country’s population.
- In **Korea**, the 5 most common last names alone account for more than half of the population.
- Japanese** last names are much more diverse but there is no “middle name” convention, which makes it impossible to differentiate when two or more people share the same first & last name.

**Publishers starting to mandate ORCID in manuscript submission**

ORCID provides a unique identifier for all researchers that can be linked to their different research works and activities across multiple platforms. It also serves to distinguish authors with similar names and simplify searching of publications databases (such as PubMed, Scopus, etc.) to avoid retrieving articles by authors with similar names. Close to 1.8 million researchers have already created their ORCID iD. The service is non-profit and community driven.




From 1 January 2016, we will require the submitting author to provide an ORCID identifier as part of the manuscript submission process. Details of the practicalities will be provided shortly, but don't worry, it takes less than a minute to register for an ORCID iD and it's free of charge. A [recent survey](#) carried out by ORCID indicates strong support in the research community for mandates by publishers, funders, and universities.

ABSTRACT:  
Raman spectroscopy is among the most widely employed methods to investigate the properties of several fields of study. Evolution in materials science allowed us to fabricate suitable substrates, all capable to enhance the electromagnetic field of the signals coming from the samples which at this to be in most cases singles or a few molecules. This particular variation of the classical technique (Surface Enhanced Raman Spectroscopy). In this work, the enhancement of the electromagnetic field by manipulation of the optical properties of metals with respect to their size. By using electrodeless (bottom up technique), gold and silver nanoparticles were deposited in nanostructured patterns of silicon wafers by means of electron beam lithography (top down technique). Rhodamine 6G in aqueous solution at extremely low concentration (10<sup>-8</sup> M) was adsorbed on the resultant dimers and the collection of the Raman spectra demonstrated the high efficiency of the substrates.
